3. Increase the quality, availability, and effective use of health insurance coverage for cancer prevention and treatment.  Output  Description:	<ul> <li>Support promotion and expansion of access to affordable public and private health insurance options that provide full coverage of cancer prevention and treatment services.</li> <li>Protect existing laws and programs providing affordable, quality cancer prevention and treatment services (Affordable Care Act, BadgerCare, WI Well Woman Program, etc.).</li> <li>Educate WI Cancer Council members on how to assist individuals in choosing and using insurance coverage to access all available cancer screening and treatment options.</li> <li>Support increased Medicaid reimbursement for providers.</li> <li>Continue to monitor the cost of cancer care and educate WI Cancer Council members on the issue.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Priority 4 – Increase HPV vaccine completion</li> <li>Priority 7 – Increase use of recommended cancer screenings</li> <li>Priority 8 – Increase access to cancer genetic risk assessment and counseling</li> <li>Priority 9 – Increase access to quality cancer care and services</li> <li>Priority 12 – Increase participation in cancer clinical trials</li> </ul>
