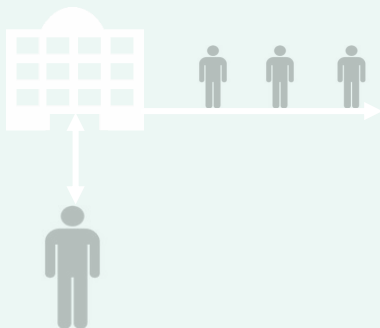
MEMBER ORGANIZATION

MEMBER REPRESENTATIVES

Individuals/Employees that work within a **MEMBER ORGANIZATION** and utilize the benefits of their organization's membership to implement the WI Comprehensive Cancer Control (CCC) Plan.



LEAD MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE

A **MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE** that also serves as the main point of contact between the WI Cancer Council and the **MEMBER ORGANIZATION** they represent.

MEMBER ORGANIZATION Responsibilities

- Appoint a Lead Member Representative for your organization's membership to the WI Cancer Council.
- Provide time for the Lead Member Representative and Member Representatives to complete Commitment Forms online.
- Promote WI CCC Plan implementation within your organization.
- Incorporate the WI CCC Plan into your organization's strategic plans.
- Encourage staff to join the WI Cancer Council and participate in its activities.
- Keep up-to-date on news and updates sent by the WI Cancer Council and WI CCC Program.
- Collaborate with other WI Cancer Council Member Organizations.

- Collaborate with other WI Cancer Council members to increase collective strengths and resources to achieve cancer control outcomes.
- Receive tools and resources to support your organization's efforts to implement the WI CCC Plan.

MEMBER ORGANIZATION

Representation

- Member Organizations can appoint an unlimited number of Member Representatives from their organization to participate in the WI Cancer Council.
- One of these representatives must be appointed as a Lead Member Representative, the main contact between the WI Cancer Council and Member Organization.

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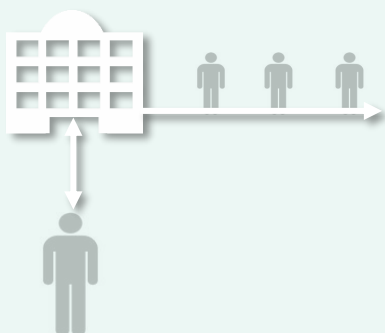
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LEAD MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE Responsibilities

- Serve as your organization's main contact with the WI Cancer Council and complete their Member Organization Commitment Form online.
- Promote and champion the WI CCC Plan within your organization.
- Annually engage Member Representatives within your organization to coordinate and discuss membership.
- Meet with your organization's leadership to establish opportunities to coordinate and utilize membership.
- Encourage attendance at Annual Meeting and participation in WI Cancer Council activities.
