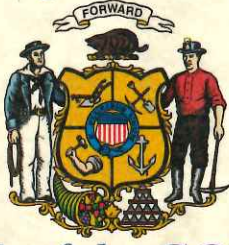


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim April 10 – 14, 2017 as

CANCER REGISTRARS WEEK


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
