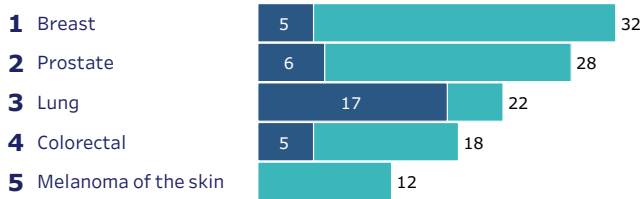

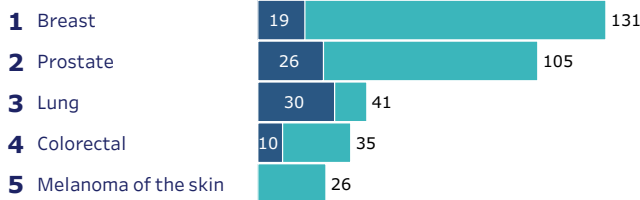

Deaths / Cases per year



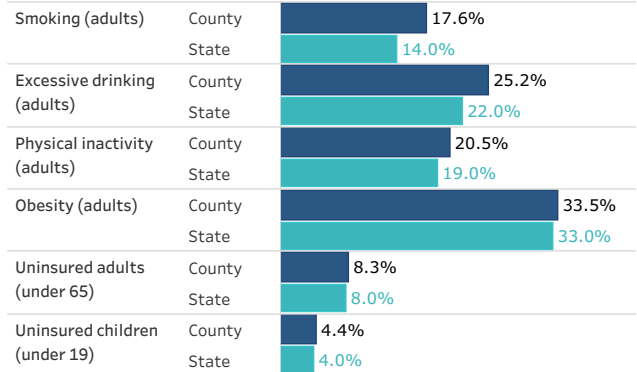
Deaths / Cases per 100,000 residents per year (age-adjusted)



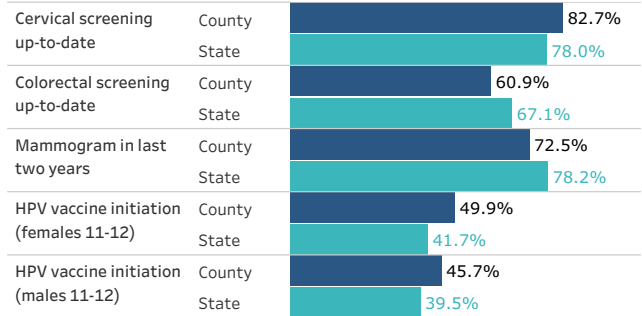

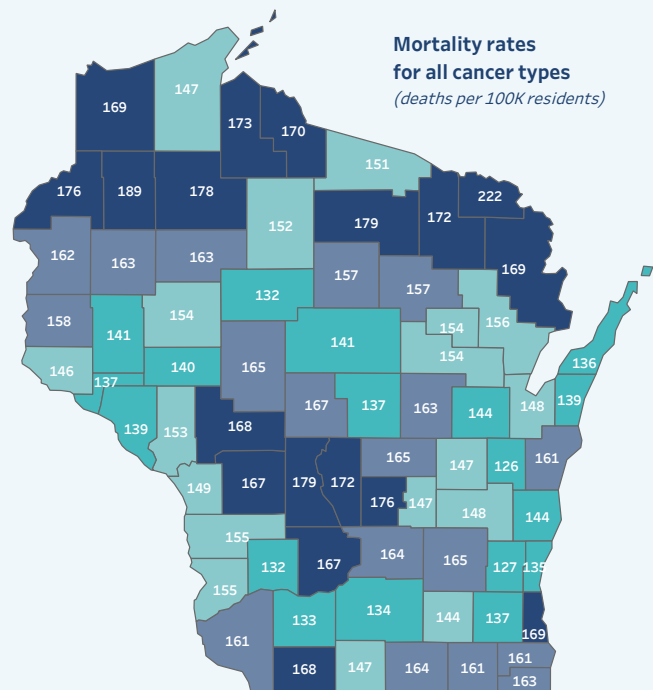
