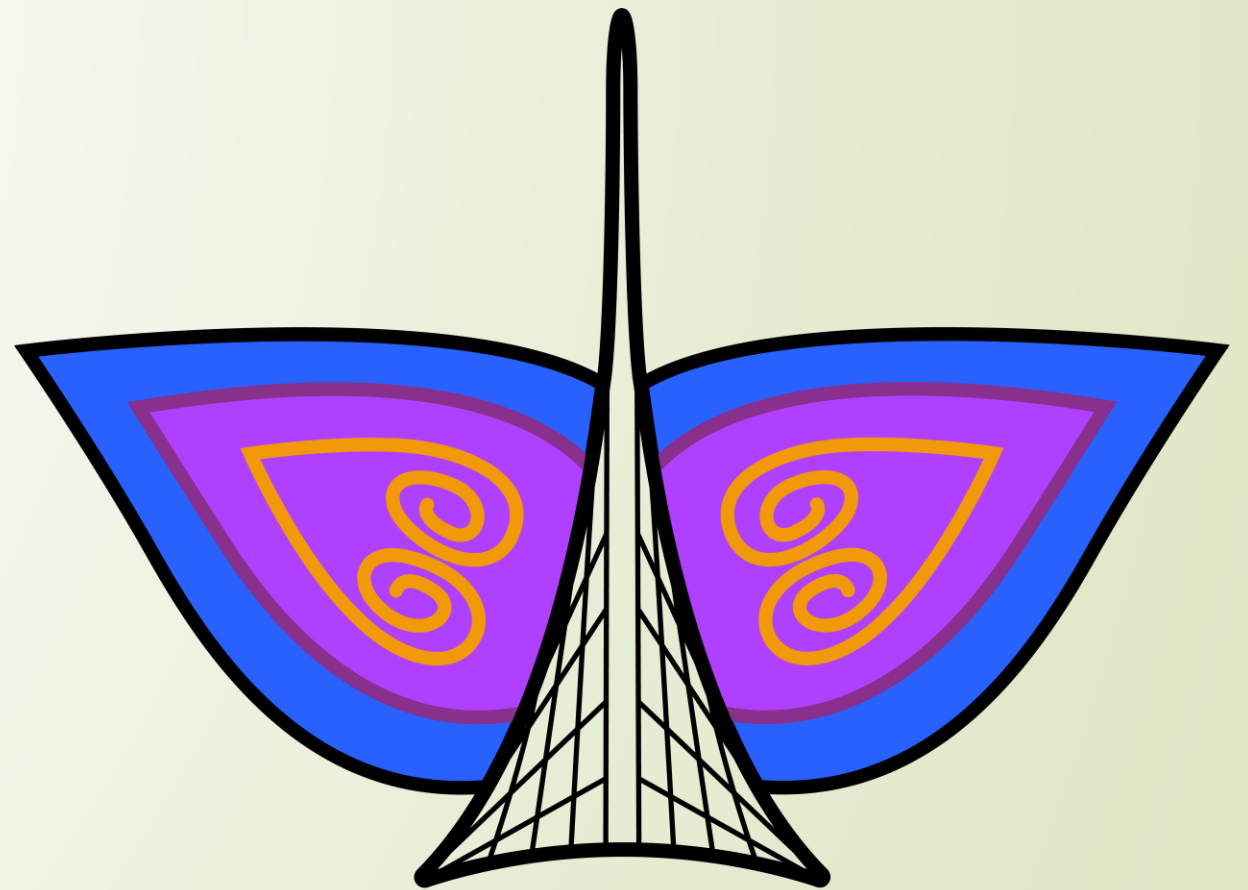

Case management

- Data Entry

- Navigate health Insurance

- ❖ Conduct home visits to call insurance for coverage
- ❖ Assist participants apply or renew Medicaid/Badger care
- ❖ Assist with application forms to apply for screenings covered by WWWP, Breast Cancer Assistant funds, Hayat Pharmacy, etc.

- Assist with making health appointments

- ❖ Conduct home visits to call clinic and/or hospitals to set up appointments
- ❖ Set up interpreters for appointments
- ❖ Set up transportations



Case management Cont.

- Assist with non-emergency medical transportation (Veyo, ACS)
 - ❖ Be at client's home to make sure client gets in the cab, follow the cab to appointments and to client's home to make sure client gets home safely
- Support and accompany at appointments
 - ❖ Provide support at appointments, be the second ear, advocate and ask questions on behalf of clients, make sure client gets the right and qualified interpreter, simplify medical jargon
- Read mail/test results
- Medication management
- Assist clients' family members if needed
- Refer clients to social services

Monthly Workshops

- Clinical Breast Exams (CBE)
- blood pressure checks
- blood sugar checks
- vision screening
- educational workshop
- Prostate Specific Antigen testing (PSA)

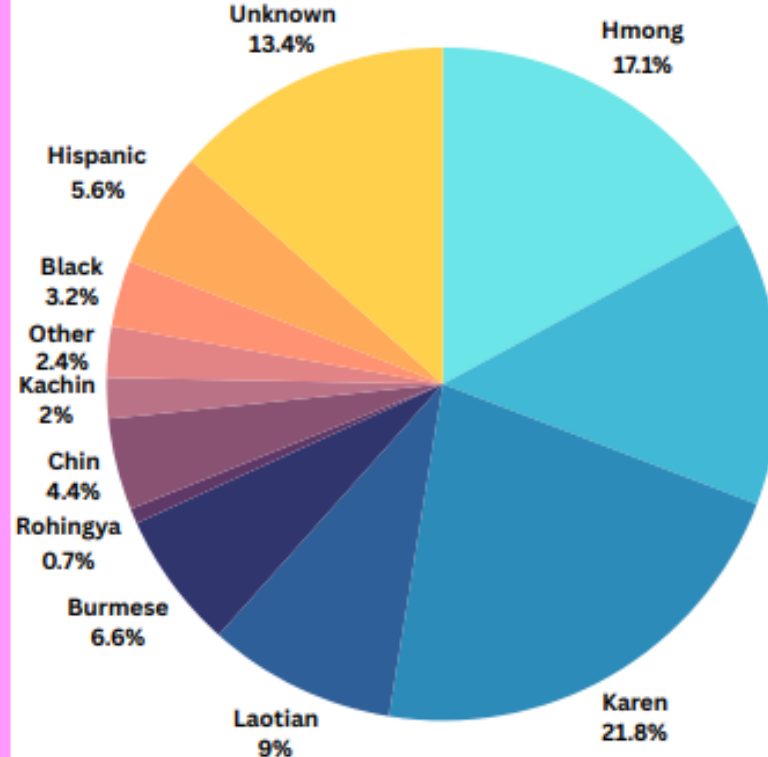

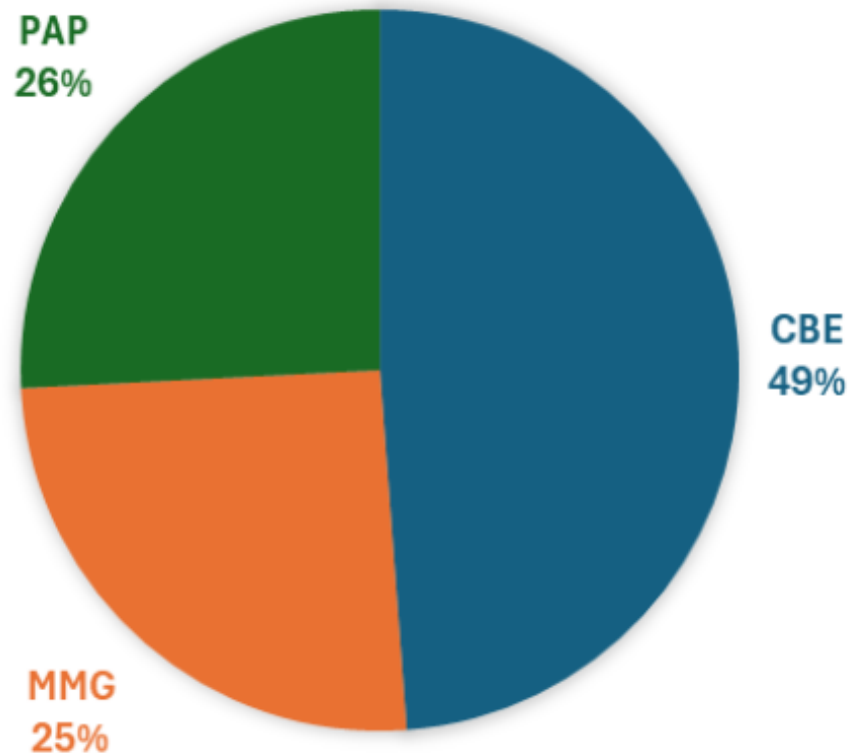
