# Implementation Action Plans: Development Process



## 4 Priorities Emerged

- ▶ Increase awareness of the connection between alcohol and cancer risk
- ▶ Increase HPV vaccine completion
- ▶ Increase cancer screening rates
- ▶ Increase access to quality cancer care and services



## HPV Vaccine Activities

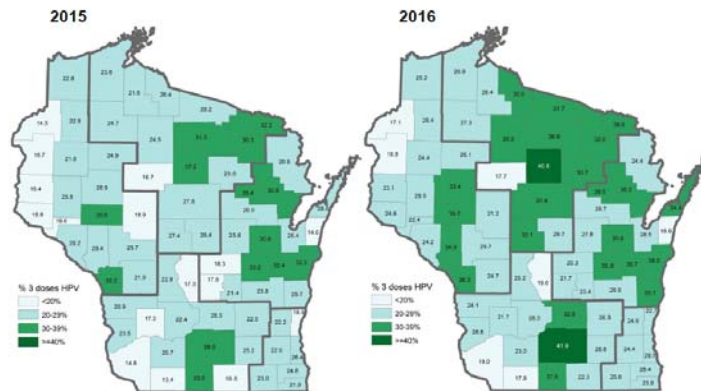
- ▶ 2014 -
  - ▶ Released HPV issue brief & infographic
  - ▶ Collaborated to offer HPV Summit in Madison, WI
- ▶ 2015
  - ▶ Conducted environmental scan of HPV-related activities
- ▶ 2016
  - ▶ Released position statement supporting use of HPV vaccine as cancer prevention
  - ▶ MD/MPH intern explored health system activities
  - ▶ Collaborated to offer two HPV Summits in Wausau and Milwaukee, WI
- ▶ 2017
  - ▶ Released second position statement by NCI Cancer Centers
  - ▶ MD/MPH intern explored HPV vaccine within school-based clinics
  - ▶ Collaborated to offer two HPV Summits in Green Bay and Eau Claire, WI



## Most Common Barriers:

- ▶ Lack of understanding about HPV infection
- ▶ Barriers to getting the three shots
- ▶ Requests to delay HPV vaccination
- ▶ Belief that the adolescent is not at risk
- ▶ Belief that the child is too young
- ▶ Lack of knowledge that vaccine is 3 shots
- ▶ Reluctance to discuss sexuality
